The information presented reflects the exact policy as articulated by the franchise and/or venue in their on-line fan guides or venue rules, regulations and policies. In addition, in several instances, most notably for NASCAR and the NBA/WNBA, policies were identified through direct communication with franchise and/or venue staff (e.g., public relations, operations) and there a few venues/franchises for which no policy could be identified or confirmed.

It is our intention that this information will help consumers and sports fans who are concerned about exposure to tobacco smoke to make better, more informed purchasing decisions about attending sporting events and venues throughout the country. This will enable consumers for whom no smoking policies are preferable, to patronize those teams and venues with greater frequency and to better target their purchases to avoid tobacco smoke in those venues that still permit smoking in certain sections or areas of those arenas. This information will also enable franchises and venues to compete for the health conscious sports fan who is concerned about exposing themselves, their families and children, and their friends to tobacco smoke.

The information in this resource guide will be updated periodically to reflect changes in venue/franchise smoking and non-smoking policies and as policies for venues/franchises that could not be found are identified and confirmed.



MAJOR LEAGUE BASEBALL¹

Anaheim Angels

“Smoking - For the health and comfort of others, smoking will not be permitted in the seating areas, suites, concourses and restrooms. Smoking will be allowed in designated areas such as the ramps and the Courtyard areas. Guests who fail to comply with this policy may be subject to ejection from the ballpark.”

Arizona Diamondbacks

“SMOKING POLICY - For the comfort of our guests, smoking at the ballpark is permitted in designated smoking areas only. These areas are:

- Main Concourse*
- *Outside of Gate A (North place)
- *Outside of Gate J (East)
- *Outside of Gate K (Northeast)”

Atlanta Braves

“Smoking - There is no smoking in seating areas. There are designated smoking areas throughout the ballpark. Please see ballpark personnel for specific locations.”

Baltimore Orioles

“Smoking Policy - For the health and comfort of others, smoking is not permitted in the seating areas, lower bullpen area, Flag Court, restrooms, suite lounge areas, or the inner perimeters of the upper and lower concourses as well as Eutaw Street corridor. Fans who fail to comply with this policy after appropriate warnings may be subject to ejection from the ballpark.”

Boston Red Sox

“Smoking - Smoking is not allowed in Fenway Park.”

Chicago Cubs

“Smoking – Only on concourse, not in stands.”²

Chicago White Sox

“Smoking will be permitted in designated areas only. Please see a ballpark employee if you need assistance.”

Cincinnati Reds

“**SMOKING POLICY** - Smoking is prohibited in all seating areas of Great American Ball Park. Smoking is permitted on the concourse away from the seats only in the following designated locations:

Terrace Level

On the concourse only near Sections 138, 139, 140, 141, 142, 143, 144, 145, 146

View Level

On the concourse only near Sections 512 and 536”

Cleveland Indians

“**SMOKING** - There is no smoking in the seating areas. There are designated smoking areas throughout Jacobs Field.”

Colorado Rockies

“**Smoking** - Denver City Ordinance 655 prohibits smoking in Coors Field except in designated smoking areas. All seating areas are classified as non-smoking. Designated smoking areas are marked by yellow lines and are located as follows:

MAIN CONCOURSE

- * At the backside of the Main Concourse behind the bullpens
- * Inside the 22nd Street entrance (Gate B) behind section 114
- * Inside the 21st and Blake Street entrance (Gate C) behind section 122
- * Inside the 20th and Blake Street entrance (Gate D) behind section 130
- * Backside of the concourse behind section 148

CLUB LEVEL

- * Outdoor terrace behind sections 214-216 (after the start of the game)
- * Outdoor terrace behind sections 236-238
- * Outside Club Level entrance behind section 247

SUITE LEVEL

- * Club Level terraces
- * Outside Suite Level, leftfield corner of suite entrance, across from suite 56

UPPER CONCOURSE

- * Behind sections 303, 311, 314, 319, 325, 335, 347 and near the Clocktower

ROCKPILE

- * On the elevated platforms near stairwells.
- * Behind the elevator shaft on Concourse Level”

Detroit Tigers

“SMOKING POLICY - Smoking is prohibited in all seating areas, rest rooms, concession stands/areas and concourses (except where specifically designated for smoking) of Comerica Park. Designated smoking areas are the open air area of ramps behind sections 125 and 140, the concourse area behind section 101-102, the open air area of ramps behind sections 325 and 340, and the rooftop areas behind sections 215-216. There may also be smoking areas available within the private club areas, the Beer Hall and restaurants.”

Florida Marlins

“Smoking Policy - Smoking is not permitted in the seating areas, restrooms, concourse or any area of the Club Level of the Pro Player Stadium. Smoking is permitted on the ramps of each level.”

Houston Astros

“Smoking - Smoking at Minute Maid Park is allowed only in designated smoking areas. Fans seated in the Club, Suite and Upper Concourse levels may go to any of the roof terraces or ramps. Ask any ballpark personnel for the exact locations of these areas. Fans in the Main Concourse may go to the exterior smoking area behind Section 120 or leave the building at the Right Field, South Home Plate or Union Station gates. Fans must have their ticket punched before exiting the building and present their ticket stub upon re-entry. Smoking is strictly prohibited on any concourse or in any of the stairwells.”

Kansas City Royals

“SMOKING - Smoking in Kauffman Stadium is allowed in designated areas located throughout the stadium, in addition to the circular ramps. Smoking is not permitted in seating areas, restrooms, or concourses, except where designated. Live game action monitors have been installed at such designated smoking areas along with the Royals Radio Network broadcast.”

Los Angeles Dodgers

“Smoking - For the health and comfort of others, smoking is not permitted in the public seating areas or restrooms. Smoking is permitted only in designated areas.”

Milwaukee Brewers

“Smoking Policy - In an effort to accommodate all guests, smoking is allowed only in designated areas of Miller Park. Designated smoking areas for Guests are located on identified outer plaza areas on the Field Level outside of section 110, Friday's outdoor patio and the Beer Garden, located in the right field corner of the Terrace Level concourse. Smoking is prohibited in the entire seating bowl of the ballpark as well as all concourses and restrooms.”

Minnesota Twins

“Smoking Policy - In accordance with the Minnesota Indoor Clean Air Act, there is no smoking in the Metrodome. Smoking is permitted in the outer gate areas between the turnstiles and revolving doors only.”

New York Mets

“Smoking Restrictions - Under New York City Law, smoking is prohibited in most areas of Shea Stadium including all seating areas. Smoking is permitted only in specifically designated public areas and in certain enclosed private rooms.”

New York Yankees

“SMOKING POLICY - Law prohibits smoking throughout the Stadium. Violators will be ejected from the ballpark immediately.”

Oakland Athletics

“Smoking - Smoking is allowed in the Stadium, only in the following locations:

- Main Concourse inside entrance Gates A & B.
- Club Concourse near Gates AA & BB
- Open air Club Concourse areas away from concession and merchandise stands, Sections 200-209 and 225-234.
- View Level Concourse away from concession stands, Section 311-323.
- View Level Bleacher Concourse, Section 335-355.”

Philadelphia Phillies

“Smoking - Citizens Bank Park is primarily a smoke-free facility. Smoking is permitted in designated areas only. As shown on the ballpark directory and maps, these areas include certain entryways, stairwells and landings. Smoking is prohibited in the seating bowl, concourses, Ashburn Alley, restrooms and in all premium seating areas.”

Pittsburgh Pirates

“SMOKING POLICY - In consideration of the health and comfort of others, smoking is not permitted in the seating or general concourse areas of PNC Park. Smoking is permitted in the following designated locations:

Main Concourse: Smorgasburgh and near all restroom areas

Suite Level: patio area (right field side). Smoking is only permitted in suites in which it is authorized by the suite holder.

Club Level: behind Gunner's (near freight elevators)

Upper Concourse: near Section 307 (near freight elevators).”

San Diego Padres

“SMOKING AREAS - PETCO Park is a non-smoking facility. Smoking is permitted only in the following locations, which are designated with signage and ashtrays:

Main Concourse:

Section 107 – Exterior railing
Section 114 – Ramp landing

Toyota Terrace Level:

Section 204 – Exterior railing

Upper Concourse:

Section 310 – Exterior railing
Section 321 – Exterior railing.”

San Francisco Giants

“SMOKING POLICY - SBC Park is a SMOKE-FREE facility. Limited smoking areas are available.

Smoking is Limited to:

Field/Street Level: Outside the ballpark.

Promenade Level: Above the Lefty O'Doul Entrance next to the stairs, above Marina Gate at the top of the stairs, and behind Section 135 near the Fan Lot Bridge.

AAA Club Level: The outdoor patio behind the concourse near Section 229.

View Level: The outer perimeter of the concourse behind Section 314 at the top of the wheelchair-accessible ramp, and behind Section 335 at the top of the wheelchair-accessible ramp.

Smoking is NOT PERMITTED in any other area of the Service, Promenade or Oracle Suite Levels, Fan Lot, Center Field, or Arcade.

San Francisco Municipal Code (Health Code), Part II, Chapter V, Article 19E, Sections 1009.5-1009.10: Customers violating this ordinance will be asked to cease smoking or to otherwise comply by moving to a location in the stadium where smoking is permitted. Those who refuse to comply with this ordinance will be subject to enforcement penalties under the ordinance.”

Seattle Mariners

“Smoking - Smoking is prohibited in Safeco Field except in approved smoking areas. The smoking areas are designated by signage, ashtrays and yellow lines. The use of smokeless chewing tobacco is not allowed in the ballpark. Please ask any Host or stop by any Guest Service Center for further information.”

St. Louis Cardinals

“Smoking - Smoking is not permitted in the seating area of Busch Stadium. It is also not permitted in elevators, restrooms or the lobby. Guests who wish to smoke must go to a designated smoking area. There are many smoking areas located throughout the Stadium, most equipped with television monitors, ash receptacles and countertops for convenience and comfort. The locations are as follows:

- Level Two
 - Redbird Inn
 - Homeplate Deluxe Suite Lounge (for Deluxe Suite guests only)
- Level Three
 - Near each set of steps coming up from Level Two
- Bleachers
 - Concourse behind Sections 593 and 507
- Level Four
 - All outer ramp landings
- Level Five
 - Enclosed interior areas of Deluxe Suites
 - Ramp landing outside Diamond Suites
 - Ramp landing outside Party Rooms
- Level Six
 - All outer ramp landings

Note: Cigarettes are no longer available for purchase at Busch Stadium.”

Tampa Bay Devil Rays

“**Smoking** - There is no smoking in seating areas. There are designated smoking areas on the open-air gate ramps and in the cigar bars.”

Texas Rangers

“**SMOKING POLICY** - Arlington City ordinance prohibits smoking in all seating sections, restrooms and concession areas of Amerquest Field; however, there are several sections of the outer concourses that have been designated as smoking areas.”

Toronto Blue Jays

“**SMOKING REGULATIONS** - Fans - According to City of Toronto by-law 406-79, smoking is not permitted in any seating or concourse area of SkyDome. Failure to comply with this by-law may result in ejection from the stadium and/or criminal prosecution. Smoking is permitted in "Puffers Lounge" located behind aisle 136 on the 100 level, and on the 500 level in "Upper Puffer's Lounge" located behind aisle 511. As well, two smoking lounges are located on the 200 level at Aisle 215 and 233.”

Washington Expos

“**Smoking** - Smoking is allowed only in the concourse area.”*

NATIONAL FOOTBALL LEAGUE³

Arizona Cardinals

“Smoking - Stadium policy forbids smoking in public seating areas. (State law forbids smoking in restrooms.) Smoking is permitted in designated areas on stadium concourses.”

Atlanta Falcons

“SMOKING POLICY - For the comfort and health of all fans, the Georgia Dome is a smoke-free environment. There is no smoking allowed in the facility.

Smoking is permitted outside of all entry gates. If you wish to smoke while at a Falcons game, pick up a wristband at a Dome Service Center and proceed outside to the designated smoking areas. You must present your wristband and your ticket to re-enter the Georgia Dome.

Individuals who violate the smoke-free policy will be asked to leave the Georgia Dome.”

Baltimore Ravens

“Smoking - For the health and comfort of other Ravens guests, smoking is not permitted in the seating areas or restrooms. Smoking is allowed on open concourses and ramps. Suite holders may choose to smoke inside their suites only; smoking is not permitted on suite balconies. Guests who fail to comply with the policy after appropriate warnings may be subject to ejection from the stadium.”

Buffalo Bills

“SMOKING POLICY - Erie County Local Law #6 PROHIBITS smoking within the confines of the Stadium including concourses, bathrooms, concession areas, suite and club areas, and all seating areas. Smoking will be permitted only in designated smoking areas from the exterior of the Stadium wall to the interior of the Stadium fence.”

Carolina Panthers

“Smoking Policy - Smoking is prohibited in the seating bowl and all areas of the stadium except in the designated smoking areas. Fans who fail to comply with this policy after the appropriate warning will be ejected from the stadium.”

Chicago Bears

“Smoking - Is prohibited in the seating bowl and any enclosed areas, including inner concourses, restrooms, the Cadillac Club and Executive Suites. Locations where smoking is permitted:

- Colonnade Concourse
- Promenade Walkway (upper south rim of stadium)
- Miller Lite Party Deck
- South Courtyard
- Northeast corner of the Mezzanine Level
- Platform landings outside the north and south entrances of the Cadillac Club

First-time violators of the smoking policy will be asked to exchange their ticket stub for a "Smoking Card". Any patron refusing to exchange their ticket stub, will be ejected from the stadium. If a patron is then caught smoking in a non-smoking area for a second time, he or she will be ejected from the stadium. Repeated violations can result in the forfeiting of season ticket privileges.”

Cincinnati Bengals

“Smoking Policy - For the health and comfort of guests, smoking is not permitted in the seating areas, open concourses, restrooms and concessions lines. Smoking is allowed on the open-air stair landings and open ramps in designated areas. Suite holders may choose to permit smoking inside their suites; smoking in the elevators and hallways leading to the suites is not permitted. Guests who fail to comply with the policy after appropriate warnings may be subject to ejection from Paul Brown Stadium.”

Cleveland Browns

“SMOKING POLICY - Smoking is not permitted in the seating bowl, concession lines or rest rooms. In the OfficeMax Club Lounges, smoking is permitted only in the designated areas by the bars. Guests who fail to comply with this policy after the appropriate warning are subject to ejection from the Stadium without refund.”

Dallas Cowboys

“SMOKING - In accordance with a City of Irving Ordinance, smoking is not allowed at any time in the seating or restroom areas. You may smoke only on the concourse area at Texas Stadium.”

Denver Broncos

“Fan Code of Conduct - Our staff strives to make your day at INVESCO Field at Mile High an enjoyable, family-oriented experience. Therefore, the following code of conduct has been established for all fans and stadium employees in or on the stadium premises. The Code of Conduct requires that fans:

- Refrain from smoking, except in designated areas.”

Detroit Lions

“Smoking Policy – For the health and comfort of our guests, smoking is not permitted inside Ford Field.

Designated smoking areas will be directly outside every entrance Gate on Detroit Lions gamedays and other full-stadium event days. On other event days, smoking areas will be designated with signage.

Guests who fail to comply with the smoking policy after appropriate warnings may be subject to ejection.”

Green Bay Packers

“Smoking Policy -- Smoking is not allowed in the seating areas, restrooms, or inside the Lambeau Field Atrium. Fans in the stadium bowl are allowed to smoke in the main and upper concourses of the stadium, and on the three ramps that connect the two levels. Club seat and private box patrons can smoke on the two open-air terraces, located on the east and west sides of the stadium on the 400 Level.”

Houston Texans

“Smoking - In consideration of the health and comfort of others, smoking is not permitted in the seating area, on the concourses or on the ramps of Reliant Stadium. There are designated smoking terraces located on all four sides of the Field Level and Club Level and also in each corner of the Upper Level.”

Indianapolis Colts

“SMOKING POLICY - For the health and comfort of our Colts fans, smoking is prohibited in the RCA Dome. Fans who wish to smoke may go to one of the many entry points at each gate. To re-enter the stadium, you will need your ticket stub.”

Jacksonville Jaguars

“SMOKING POLICY - A City of Jacksonville Executive Order bans smoking in the seating areas, concourses, Stadium Clubs and restrooms. Smoking is allowed only on the ramps and in designated areas of the stadium. Fans who fail to comply with this policy, after the appropriate warning, are subject to ejection from the stadium. Signs are posted throughout the stadium indicating designated or non-designated smoking areas. We appreciate your cooperation in adhering to this policy.”

Kansas City Chiefs

“There is no smoking permitted in the seating sections or restrooms at Arrowhead Stadium. This includes the wheelchair ramps. Smoking will only be permitted on the concourse and the spiral ramp areas.”⁴

Miami Dolphins

“**Smoking Policy** - Smoking is not permitted in the seating areas, concourses, or any area of the Club Level of Pro Player stadium. Smoking is permitted on the ramps of each level.”

Minnesota Vikings

“**Smoking Policy** - In accordance with the Minnesota Indoor Clean Air Act, there is no smoking in the Metrodome. Smoking is permitted in the outer gate areas between the turnstiles and revolving doors only.”

New England Patriots

“**SMOKING** - There is no smoking allowed in the seating bowl of Gillette Stadium.”

New Orleans Saints

“**LOUISIANA SUPERDOME SMOKING POLICY** - As a valued Saints patron, we want you to be aware that the Louisiana Legislature recently passed legislation making the entire Superdome a smoke-free facility.

Smoking is not permitted **anywhere** inside the Superdome.

If you wish to smoke, designated smoking areas have been established outside Gates B, D, F, H on the Plaza (100) Level. Be sure to retain your portion of the game-ticket for re-entry. To facilitate access for patrons in the Loge and Terrace Levels, the escalators will be available in both directions after the crowd has entered.

The interior lobby areas will no longer be available for smoking.

We appreciate your cooperation in providing a clean air environment for all of our fans.

Please check this site periodically for updated information on designated exterior smoking policies.”

New York Giants

“Smoking is permitted on the spirals and at ground-level plazas at all gates. Smoking is prohibited in all other areas of the Stadium. “

New York Jets

“Smoking is permitted on the spirals and at ground-level plazas at all gates. Smoking is prohibited in all other areas of the Stadium.”

Oakland Raiders

“**Smoking** - Smoking is allowed in the Stadium, only in the following locations:

- Main Concourse inside entrance Gates A & B.
- Club Concourse near Gates AA & BB
- Open air Club Concourse areas away from concession and merchandise stands, Sections 200-209 and 225-234.
- View Level Concourse away from concession stands, Section 311-323.
- View Level Bleacher Concourse, Section 335-355.”

Philadelphia Eagles

“**Smoking** - In an effort to accommodate all Guests, smoking is allowed only in the following areas of the stadium: ramps, designated stairwells, and the HeadHouse Plaza. Smoking is prohibited in the seating bowl, concession lines and restrooms. Violators of this policy will be ejected from the stadium.”

Pittsburgh Steelers

“**SMOKING POLICY** - Smoking is not permitted in the seating bowl, restrooms, Coca-Cola Great Hall, clubs or Luxury Suites. Smoking is only permitted in designated smoking areas, concourses and ramps.”

San Diego Chargers

“**Smoking** - Smoking is prohibited in the open seating areas, adjacent aisle ways, and most concourse areas. SDMC 59.0103m.”

San Francisco 49ers

“**SMOKING POLICY** - Smoking is restricted to designated locations throughout the stadium. Smoking in any form is not allowed in the seating areas, tunnels, restrooms, concession areas/stands, restaurants and bars, offices or related support areas. Smoking is permitted on ramps, concourses, plazas, and parking lot areas as well as in Luxury Suites.”

Seattle Seahawks

“**Smoking Areas** - Smoking is not permitted in Seahawks Stadium seating areas or the Seahawks Exhibition Center. Guests may smoke in designated areas only, which are on each level of the Stadium. Visit Spectator Services Centers for a list of exact smoking locations.”

St. Louis Rams

“Smoking - The Edward Jones Dome is a non-smoking facility. During Rams football games, guests may leave and re-enter the building through the available main entries to smoke outdoors. Guests leaving the dome to smoke are not permitted to take alcoholic beverages outside. Guests will receive a hand-stamp that along with a torn game ticket will enable them to re-enter the Dome.”

Tampa Bay Buccaneers

“Actions Prohibited In Raymond James Stadium - smoking (except in designated locations).”

Tennessee Titans

“SMOKING POLICY - The Coliseum has a "NO SMOKING POLICY" in the seating, Suite and Club areas. We have provided areas for smokers on the ramps located at each corner of the Coliseum. In addition to the ramps, Club patrons may use the special club verandas located at Section 303 on the West side and at Section 326 on the East side. Smoking policies are subject to applicable law.”

Washington Redskins

“Smoking Policy - Smoking is not permitted in the seating areas, portals, tunnels or restrooms of FedExField. Guests wishing to smoke may do so on the open-air concourses on the Lower and Upper Levels or on any ramp.

Smoking is prohibited on the Club Level enclosed concourse. However, Club Level guests may smoke in the Humidor Cigar Bar located at Sections 306-308, outside on the patio of the Wild Goose Landing, or on any ramp. Smoking is also permitted on the Smoking Deck at the elevator tower at Gates A and E.

Suite owners determine the smoking policy for their individual suite. If the Suite owner designates their suite as a non-smoking suite, Guests may smoke outside on any ramp. There is no smoking in the Loge. Smoking is permitted inside the Owner's Club.”



NATIONAL BASKETBALL ASSOCIATION⁵

Atlanta Hawks

“Smoking Policy - Smoking is not allowed inside Philips Arena. However, there are designated smoking areas located outside the arena.”

Boston Celtics

“No smoking in the arena.”

Charlotte Bobcats

“No official policy has been set.”⁶

Chicago Bulls

“Smoking - Smoking is only allowed in designated areas of the United Center. They are located in the four corners of the public concourses.”

Cleveland Cavaliers

“Smoking Policy - Gund Arena is a smoke-free facility. Smoking is not permitted in public areas of the building. Designated smoking areas are located outside the venue.”

Dallas Mavericks

“Smoking Areas - Smoking areas are located outside the north, south, east and west entrances on the Plaza Level of American Airlines Center. An additional smoking area is located on the balcony of the Platinum Level, however, access is limited to premium level ticket holders.”

Denver Nuggets

Memphis Motorsports Park

"The State of Tennessee enforces a "Children's Act for Clean Indoor Air," the intent of which is to reduce the extent to which children are exposed to environmental tobacco smoke in facilities where children's services are provided (i.e., child care centers, schools, health care facilities).

University of Texas

“SMOKING POLICY - Beginning with the 2003 football season, in order to be in compliance with University regulations, DKR-Texas Memorial Stadium, will be a non-smoking facility. Smoking will be permitted only outside of the stadium or in an area outside the stadium proper that is within the stadium secured areas.”

Ohio State University

“Smoking - Smoking is prohibited in all areas of the stadium. There are no pass outs available.”

University of Florida

“Smoking Policy - Smoking is prohibited in all areas of Ben Hill Griffin Stadium with the exception of the designated smoking areas located in the North and South End Zones.”

West Virginia University

“Smoking Policy - Smoking is not permitted in the seating areas, aisles, or restrooms at Mountaineer Field at Milan Puskar Stadium. Fans may smoke in the concourse areas.”

Iowa University

“Kinnick Stadium Smoking Policy - The University of Iowa has a policy limiting smoking in the stadium. Smoking is prohibited in seating areas, pressbox, concourses, and the rest rooms. Smoking is allowed in designated areas only (the four marked open-air corners of the stadium).”

Kansas State University

“Smoking - KSU Stadium permits smoking only on the concourse area and not in any lines or restrooms. Complaints by other patrons will require smokers to move or extinguish their smoke.”

University of Tennessee

“Smoking is not allowed in the seating area of Neyland Stadium or areas immediately behind the seating area. It is permissible on all ramps and concession areas removed from the seating area.”³³

University of California

“SMOKING POLICY - Smoking is not permitted inside Memorial Stadium.”

Clemson University

“Our policy and the public address statement is as follows: We request that you refrain from using any tobacco products while in the seated areas of Memorial Stadium.”³⁴

University of Missouri

“Smoking is not permitted in Memorial Stadium. For everyone’s comfort, you must leave the stadium through any gate. You must obtain a hand stamp and have a valid ticket stub for re-entry.”

Auburn University

“Smoking Policy - -Smoking is prohibited in areas of spectator seating, rest rooms, first aid rooms, press box and on the field. Smoking may be permitted on the concourse/ramp areas and suites.”

University of Virginia

“Smoking is not permitted anywhere in Scott Stadium. You may smoke on the ramps outside the stadium doors.”

University of Maryland

“Out of concern for the safety of our Guests and employees, the following is prohibited:

- Smoking (except in designated areas).”

University of Utah

“The smoking policy at Rice-Eccles Stadium follows the Utah Clean Air Act which states that smoking is prohibited inside the private property. 25 feet outside of the gates should be where smoking is allowed.”³⁵

University of Wisconsin

“As a courtesy to spectators, smoking is not allowed in the seating areas, portals, concourse or restrooms. Specific gates are designated as smoking areas.”

University of Minnesota

“**Smoking Policy** - In accordance with the Minnesota Indoor Clean Air Act, there is no smoking in the Metrodome. Smoking is permitted in the outer gate areas between the turnstiles and revolving doors only.”

Purdue University

“Ross-Ade stadium is a smoke/tobacco-free environment. Tobacco use, in any form, is not allowed in any area of the stadium.”

“Smoking is prohibited in all exterior seating and aisles of Autzen Stadium ... Complaints about violations of this section shall be made to Athletic Department officials or their designated agents. Violators failing to respond to a request to extinguish their smoking materials by Athletic Department officials or their agents, may be required to leave the event. Smoking is permitted in all exterior concourse and parking areas of Autzen Stadium ...”
